


Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for County Daily percent of ED visits mentioning

















Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Broward County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning





Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness













Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for




