


#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Broward County











## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Hillsborough County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning













Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








Daily percent of ED visits mentioning











### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Washington County
