



## Biography

Adam M. Drisin is Associate Dean of Academic Affairs for the College of Architecture + The Arts at Florida International University. Before his appointment to the Office of the Dean, Drisin served as both Chair and Director at FIU's School of Architecture. Previous to joining FIU, Drisin served on the faculty at Harvard University's Graduate School of Design, the University of Tennessee and Syracuse University, where for five years he was Resident Director of Syracuse's architectural study abroad program in Florence Italy. Drisin has also been a visiting faculty member at University of Toronto and University of Maryland. His scholarship and teaching focus upon architectural pedagogy, architectural and urban design, Italian architecture and urbanism as well as the history, theory and criticism of design.

Drisin's design work and scholarship have been published in leading international journals and magazines including, *Abitare*, *Architectural Record*, *Progressive Architecture*, *306090*, *Domus*, *Parametro*, *Professione e Architetti*, *L'Espresso* and the *JAE: Journal of Architectural Education*. His architectural and urban design projects were featured at the 2000 Venice Biennale and have been published and exhibited in America, Europe and South America and are featured in the book "*Pensieri & Mattoni*" (Thoughts and Constructions). In 2008, he edited the *JAE* theme-issue titled *Collateral Damage: War & Architecture* which focused upon the manner in which architectural theory and production have appropriated and re-applied technologies, material culture as well as practices and theories from warfare and from the military industrial complex. Drisin also served as curator of an extensive international exhibition and editor of a monograph on the work of the Ticinese architects Mario Campi and Franco Pessina.

Drisin is a recent recipient of the Education Leadership Award bestowed by the American Institute of Architects and the Academic Service Award given by the Association of Collegiate Schools of Architecture. He currently sits on the editorial board of *The Journal of Architectural Education*, the pre-eminent peer-reviewed academic journal of architecture and is a member of the Board of Directors for Florida's American Institute of Architects and the Executive Board of the Miami chapter of the American Institute of Architects.

Drisin holds the Bachelor of Architecture from Cornell University and the Master of Design Studies from Harvard University. He is licensed in New York.
