






Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Columbia County




Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Franklin County






Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Gulf County




Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Lafayette County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Liberty County
