Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Collier County Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath

Weekly count of ED vists for influenza-like illness








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Union County






Weekly count of ED vists for influenza-like illness 0 3/29 Week start date




Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Volusia County










Weekly count of ED vists for influenza-like illness






