





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Weekly count of ED vists for influenza-like illness

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Weekly count of ED vists for influenza-like illness





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Weekly count of ED vists for influenza-like illness





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Calhoun County

Weekly count of ED vists for influenza-like illness







Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath









Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Weekly count of ED vists for influenza-like illness

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Weekly count of ED vists for influenza-like illness

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath









Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath










Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Dixie County

Weekly count of ED vists for influenza-like illness





Weekly count of ED vists for influenza-like illness



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Weekly count of ED vists for influenza-like illness




Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Hamilton County

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Weekly count of ED vists for influenza-like illness





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Hendry County

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Weekly count of ED vists for influenza-like illness

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath







Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath











Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath









Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath









Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Weekly count of ED vists for influenza-like illness








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Martin County

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Weekly count of ED vists for influenza-like illness



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath









Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Weekly count of ED vists for influenza-like illness







Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath









Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath









Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Weekly count of ED vists for influenza-like illness





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath









Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Walton County

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath








