



## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Alachua County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning











Daily percent of ED visits mentioning









## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Calhoun County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning











Daily percent of ED visits mentioning











Daily percent of ED visits mentioning











Daily percent of ED visits mentioning





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning










## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Escambia County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








Daily percent of ED visits mentioning









### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Hillsborough County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning









### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Lake County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning














Daily percent of ED visits mentioning

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning















### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Monroe County





### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Palm Beach County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








Daily percent of ED visits mentioning












## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Seminole County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning










Daily percent of ED visits mentioning









## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Walton County






