


Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents







Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Alachua County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning






Daily percent of ED visits mentioning

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Glades County










Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Gulf County













Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Hamilton County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents








Daily percent of ED visits mentioning









Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Indian River County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning










Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Leon County







Daily percent of ED visits mentioning





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning






Daily percent of ED visits mentioning

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning










Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Pinellas County











Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Polk County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Sarasota County











Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for St. Johns County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning





Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents







Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Suwannee County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning





Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for






Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents






