


Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents








Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning






Daily percent of ED visits mentioning




Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents

The Electronic Surveillance System for the Early Notification of Community-Based Epidemics (ESSENCE-FL) includes chief complaint data from 211 of 211 Florida EDs and 86 of 88 Florida FSEDs. Data are transmitted electronically to ESSENCE-FL daily or hourly.
