### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Broward County












### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Calhoun County










## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Collier County Daily percent of ED visits mentioning Weekly co










### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Hendry County










### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Manatee County










### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Okaloosa County

















# Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness




## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for St. Lucie County Daily percent of ED visits mentioning Weekly cour






