


Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Broward County










Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents




Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Escambia County










Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Hernando County










Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Highlands County Daily percent of ED visits mentioning Weekly count




Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Martin County Daily percent of ED visits mentioning Weekly co










Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Pasco County










Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Pinellas County










Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Seminole County










Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for St. Johns County










Number of Florida residents who tested negative per day






