




Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents


Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents




Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Alachua County

Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents

Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Baker County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Bay County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness








Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Brevard County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness









Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Broward County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Calhoun County




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness

Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Charlotte County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions


Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Collier County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness










Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness







Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents







Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness










Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness










Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents









Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness









Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions














Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Highlands County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Hillsborough County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**

Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Indian River County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Jackson County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Jefferson County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents

Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness








Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness













Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Martin County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**












Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness











Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness





Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Palm Beach County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness





Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Pasco County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness









Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Seminole County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents




Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Volusia County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in

cough-associated admissions






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Walton County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents


