Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Monroe County










Daily percent of ED visits mentioning

Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for






Number of Florida residents who tested negative per day





Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents
