


### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Alachua County











## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Highlands County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning














## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Hillsborough County










### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Leon County
