


Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Brevard County















Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents







Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Franklin County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness











Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness





Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents




