Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Alachua County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents

Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness








Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions





Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness







Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**









Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness










Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**

Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness








Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**





### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Gilchrist County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness












### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Hamilton County

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions










Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness





### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Highlands County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**

### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Hillsborough County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness














Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**









Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness










Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**


### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions





Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Osceola County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**









Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness





### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Pasco County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions





Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness












Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**











### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness









Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




### Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Union County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**











### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**







#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Walton County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness












