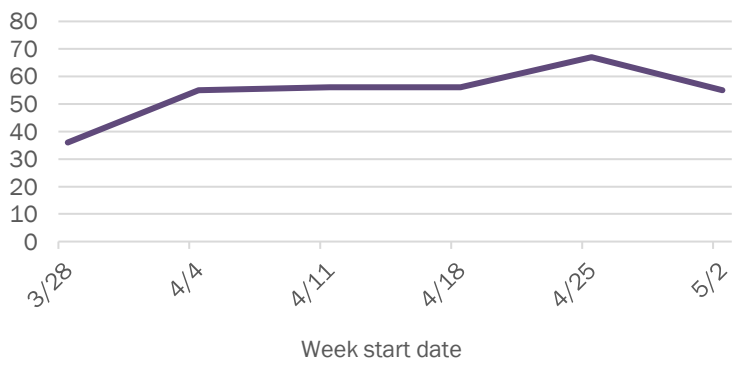


Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Alachua County

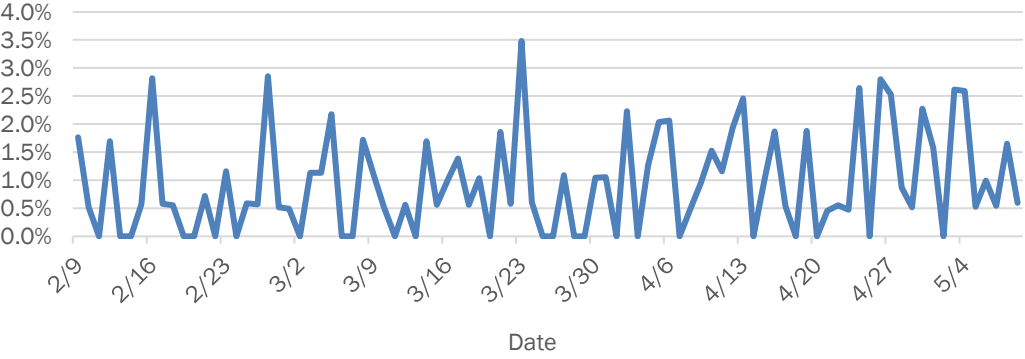
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning
cough, fever, or shortness of breath



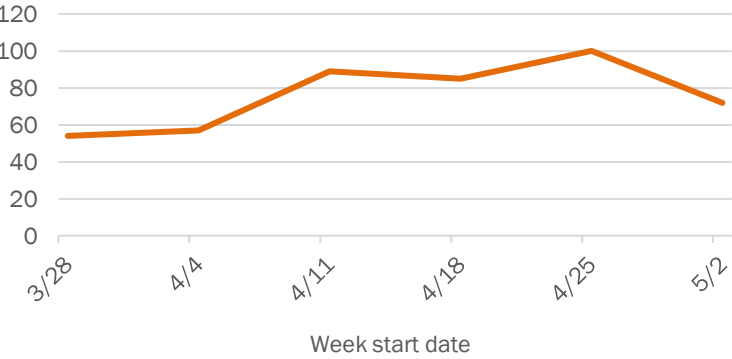
Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for

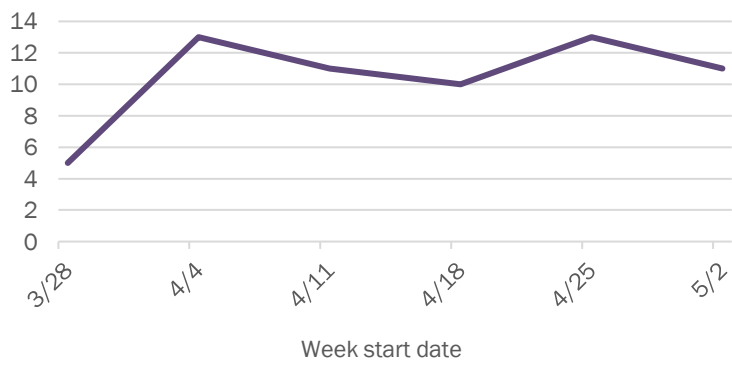

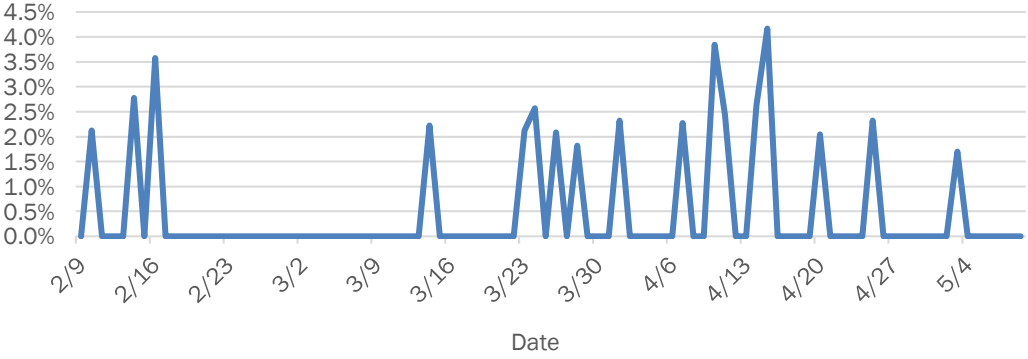
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning
cough, fever, or shortness of breath



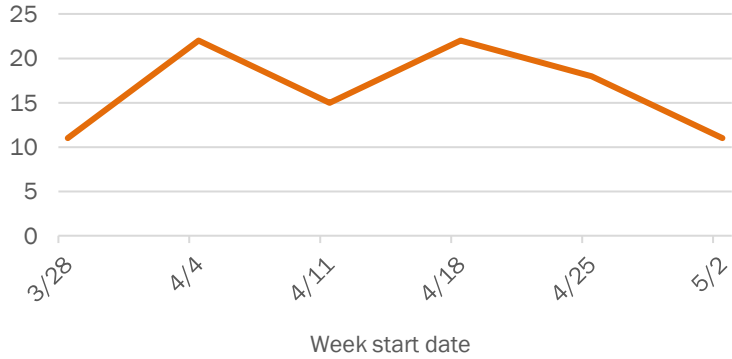
Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for

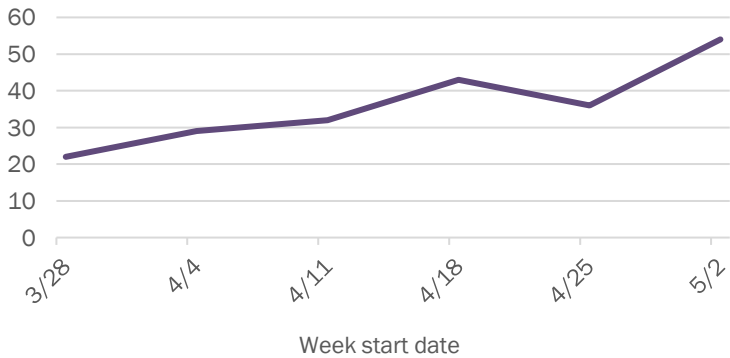

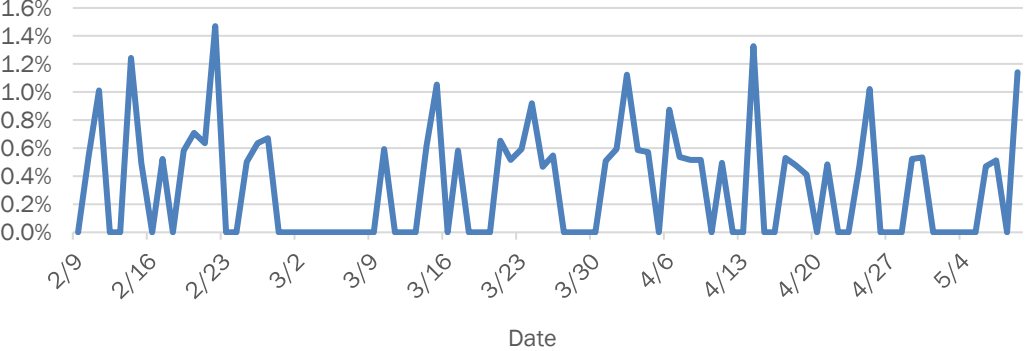
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



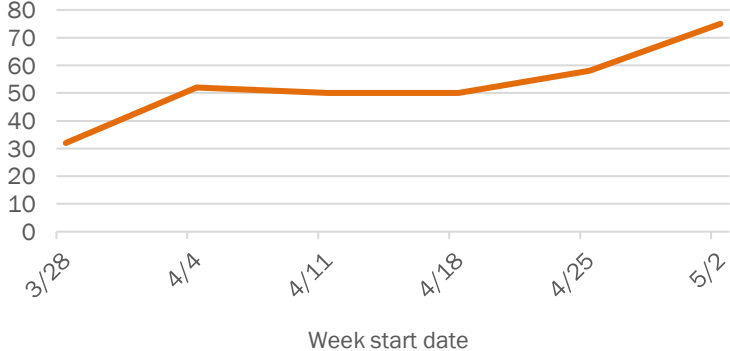
Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness

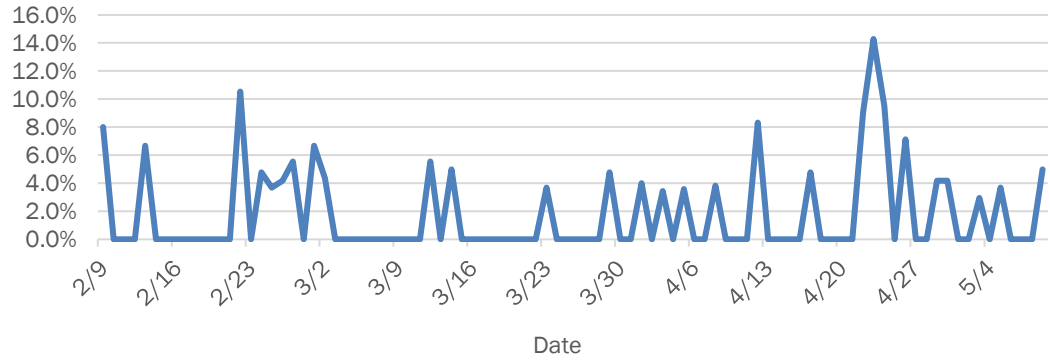
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning
cough, fever, or shortness of breath



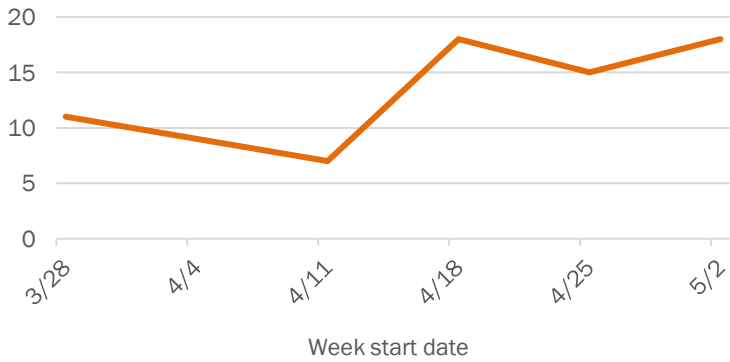
Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for

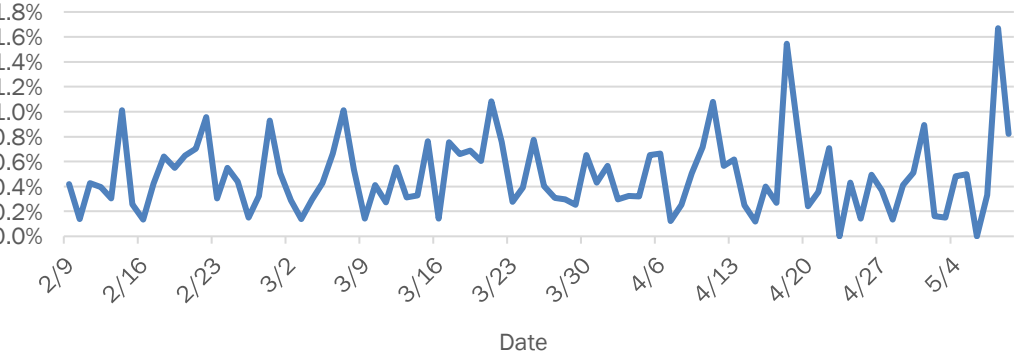

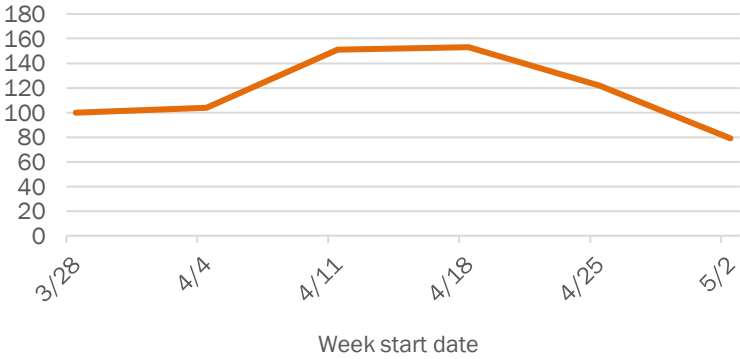
Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for

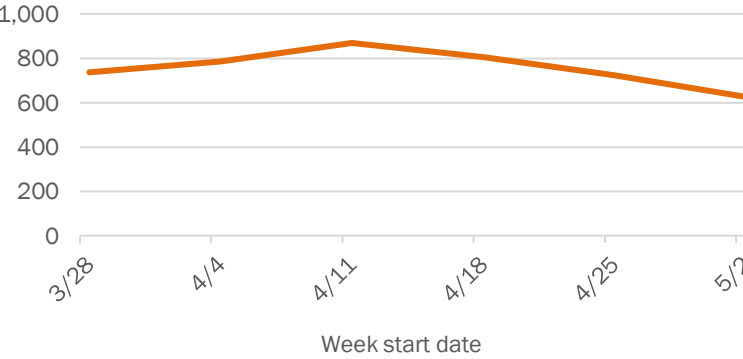
Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for

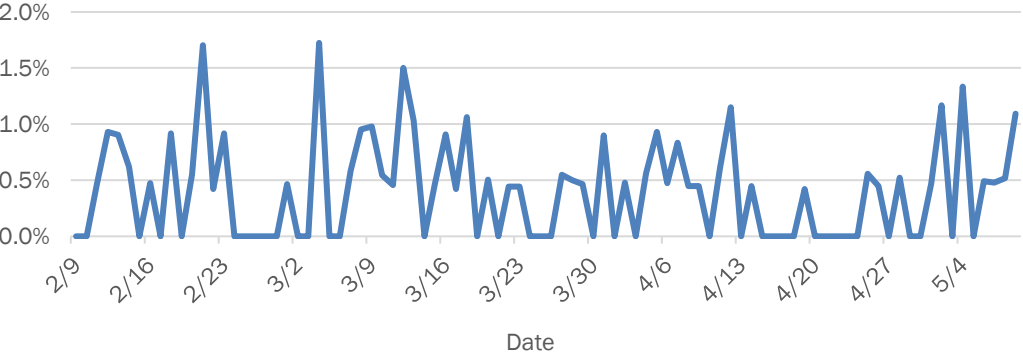
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



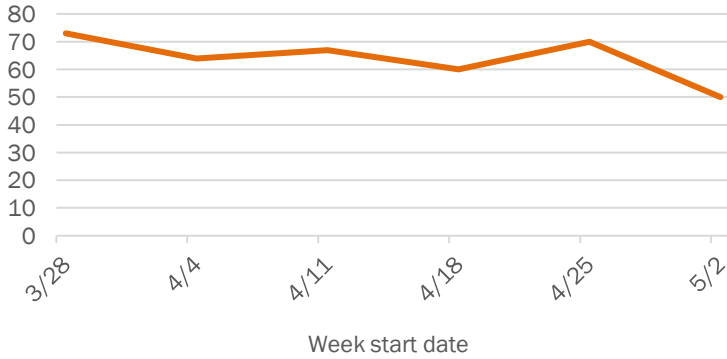
Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness

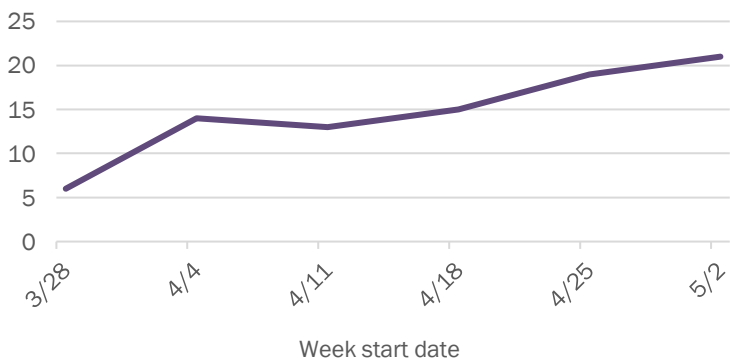

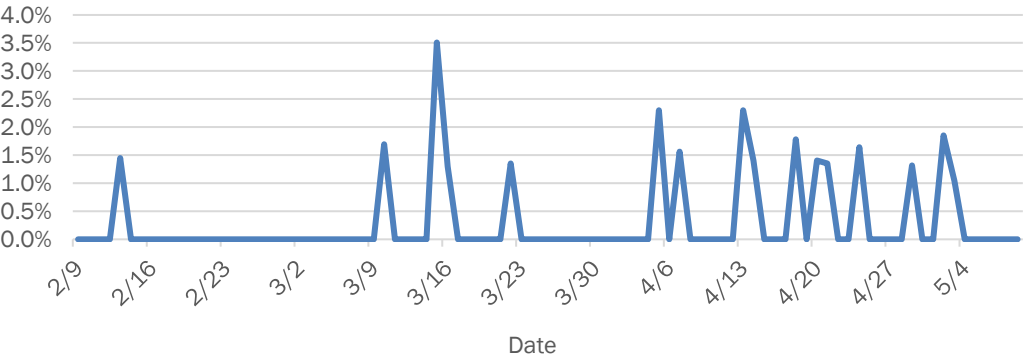
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



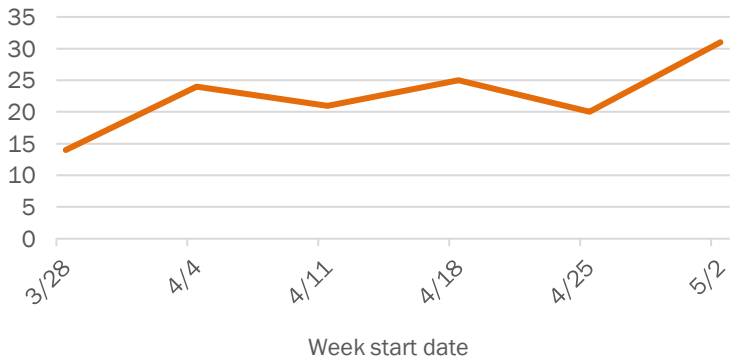
Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness

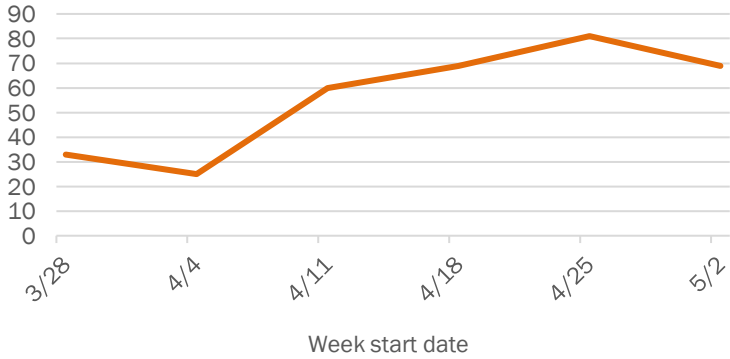
Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness

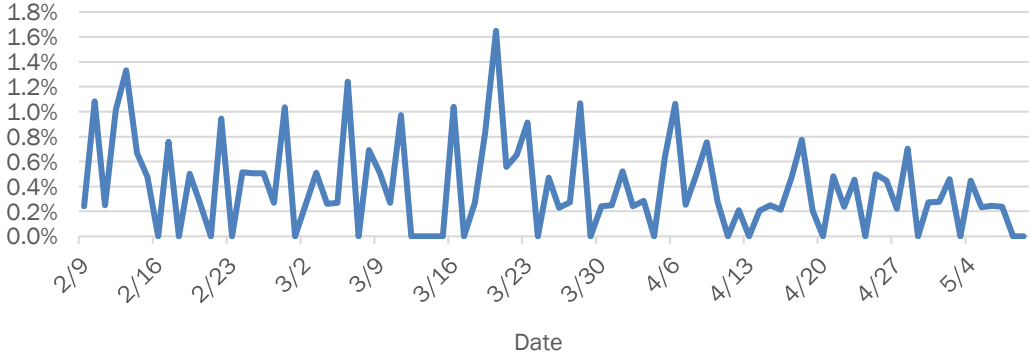

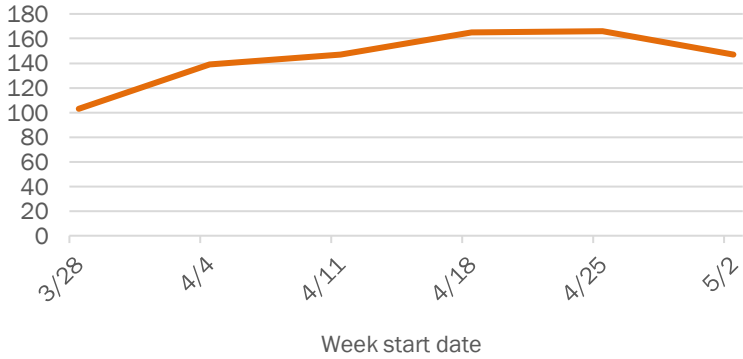

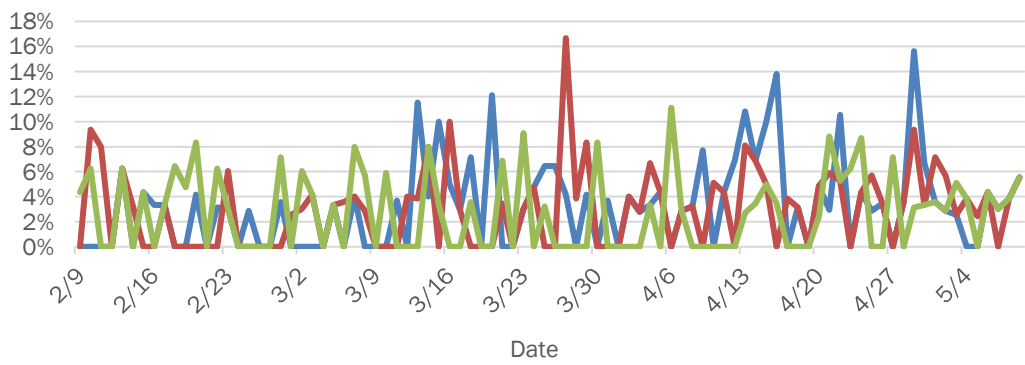
Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents

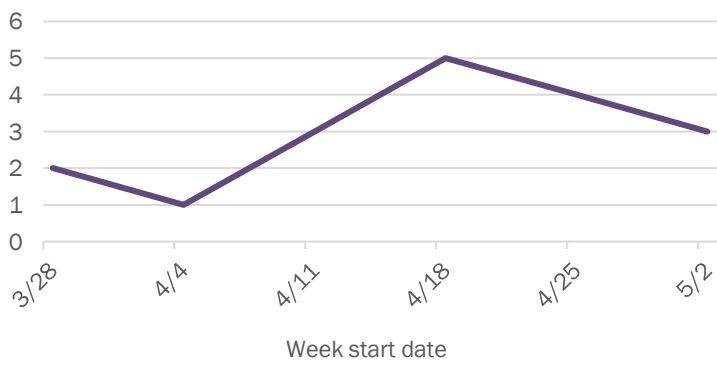


Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Taylor County

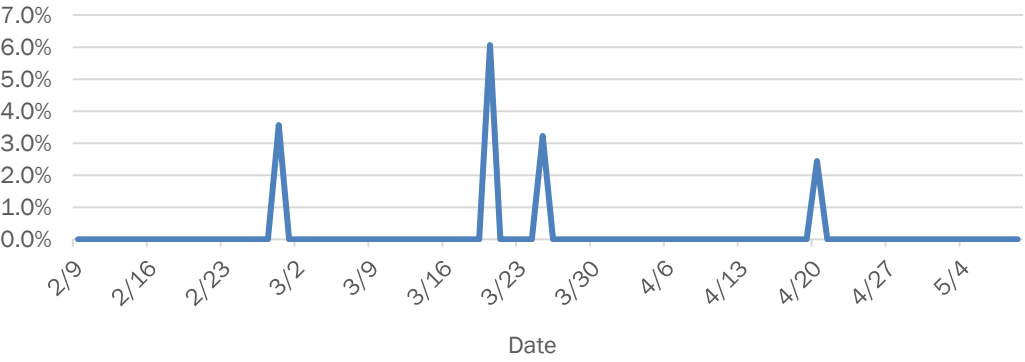
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning
cough, fever, or shortness of breath



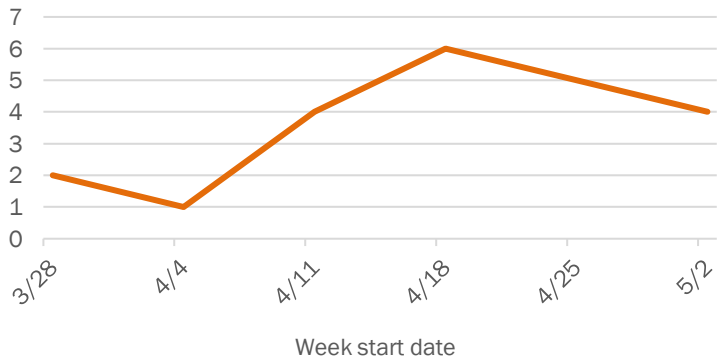
Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for

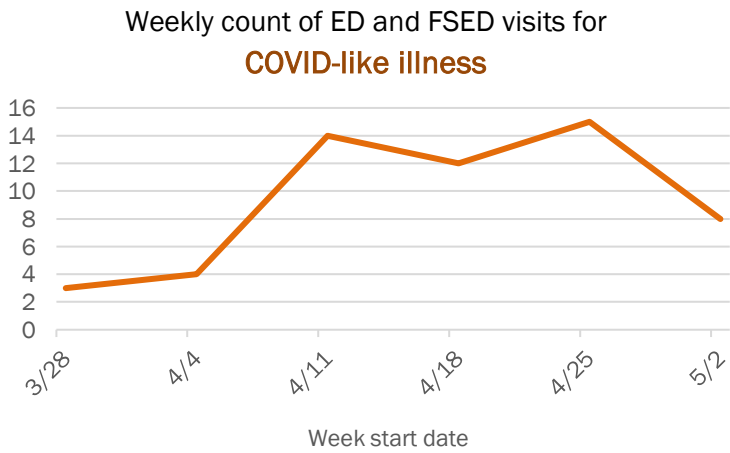
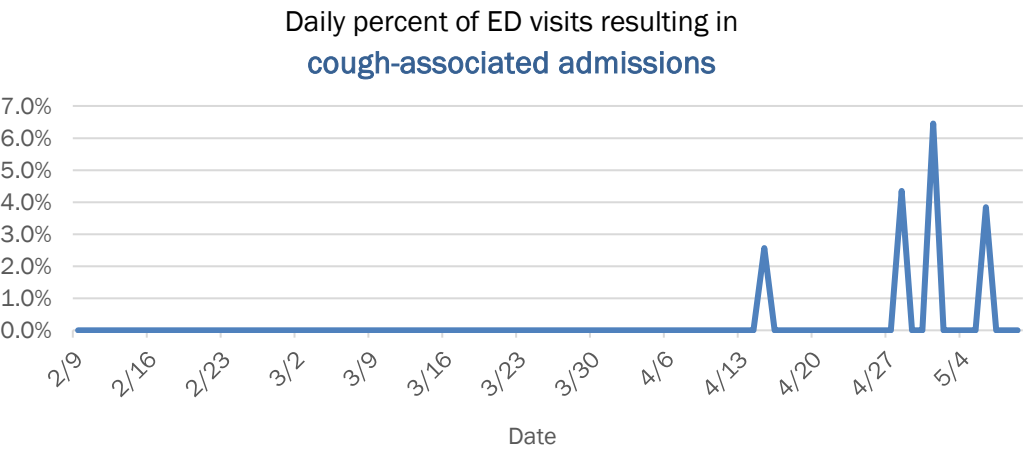
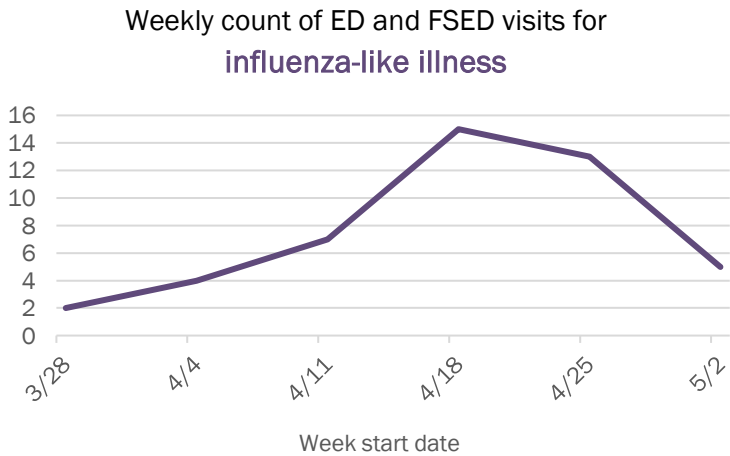
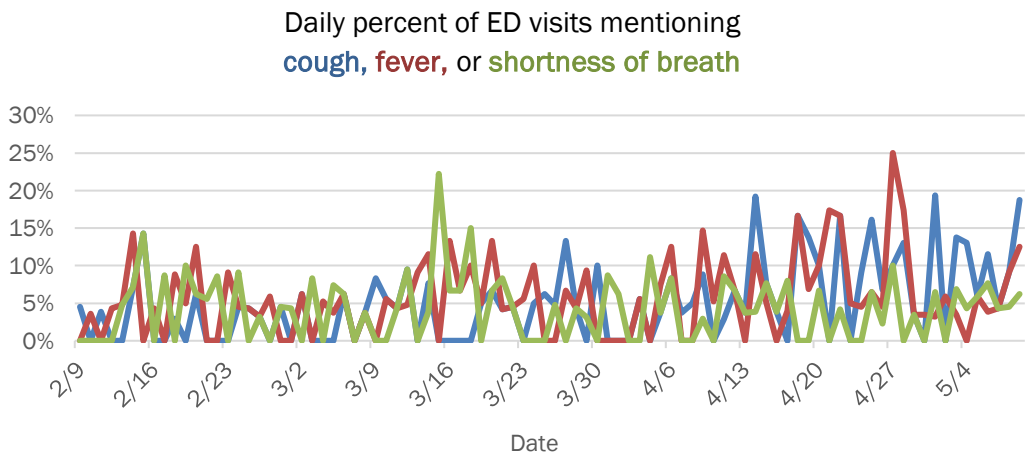


Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents

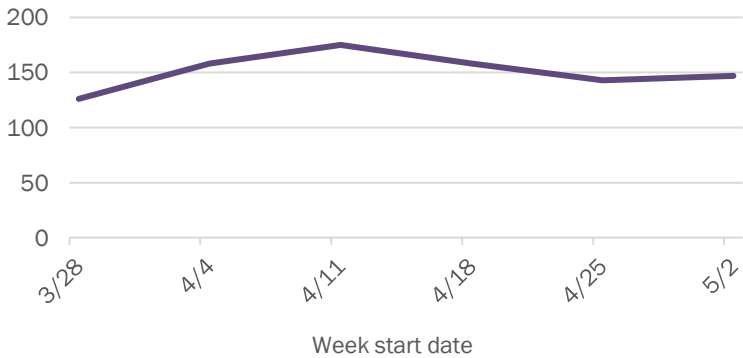


Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Volusia County

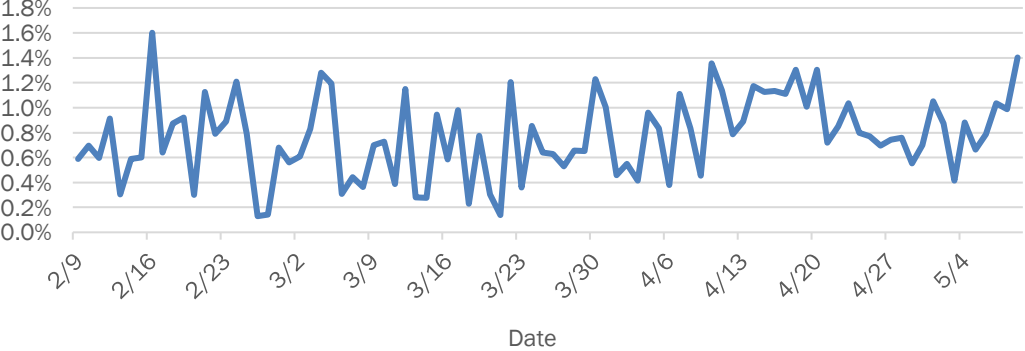
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



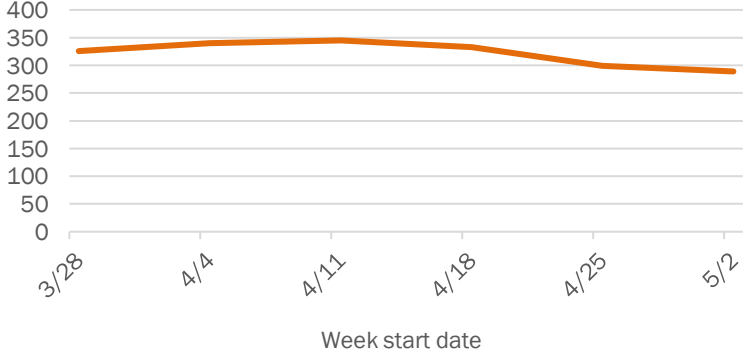
Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness

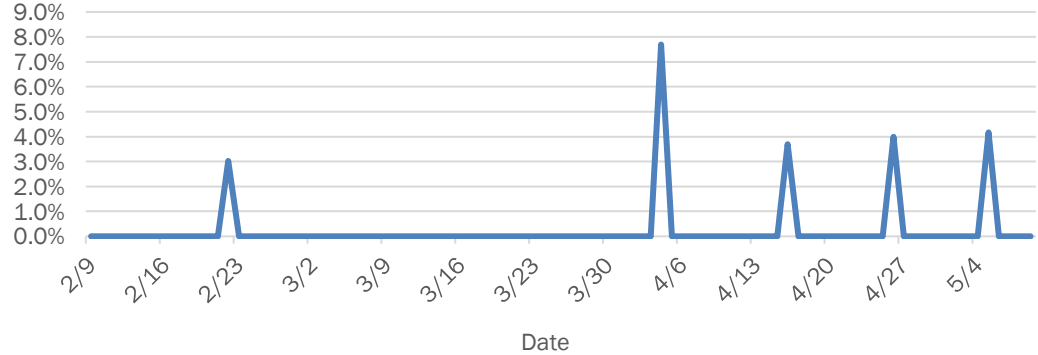
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning
cough, fever, or shortness of breath



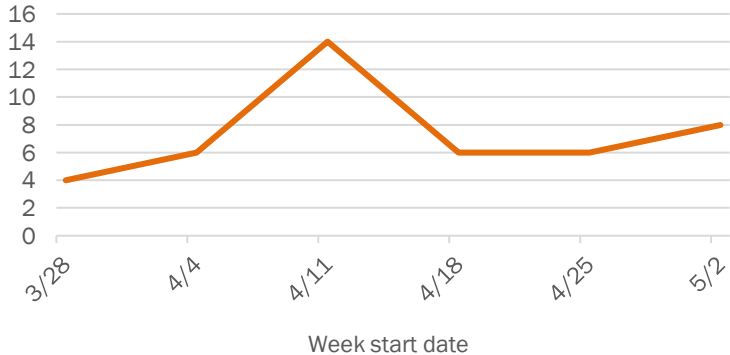
Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for

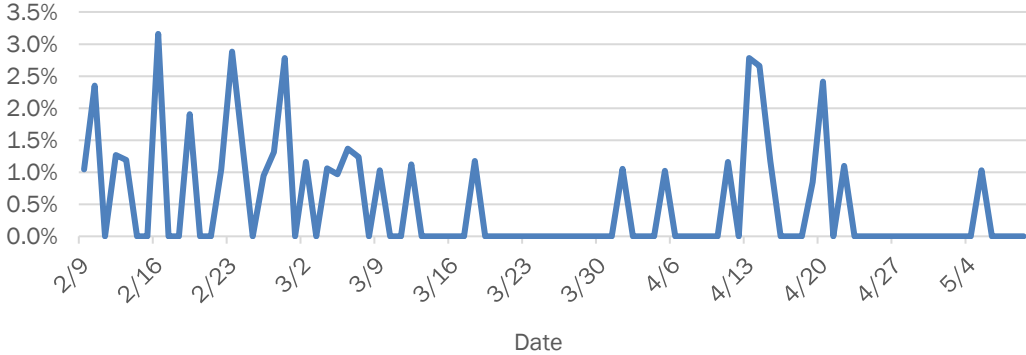

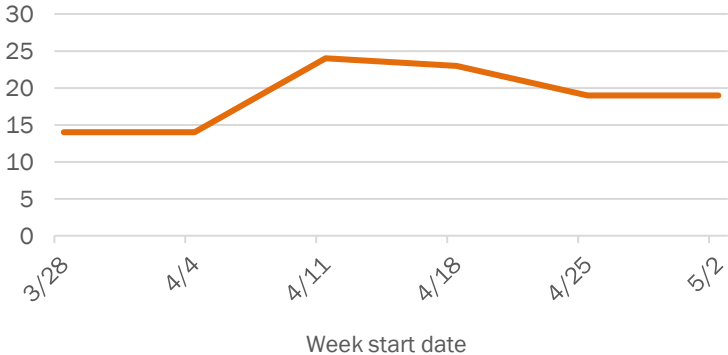
Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for

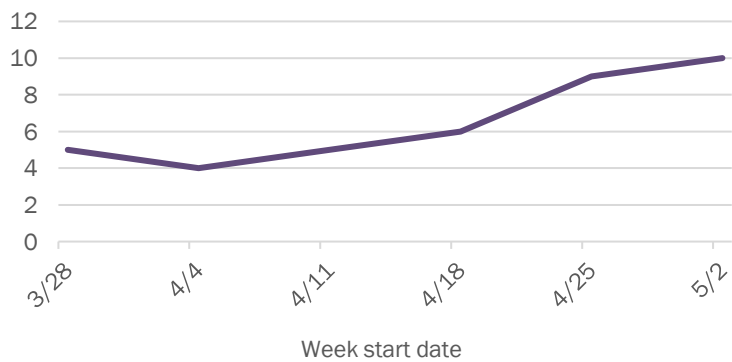


Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Washington County

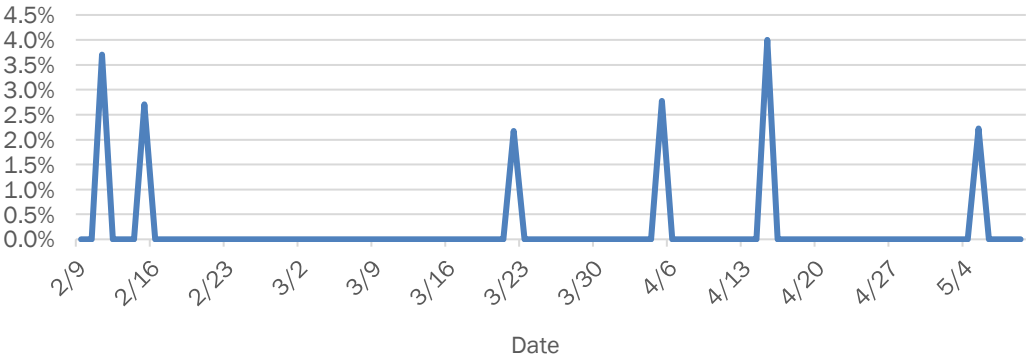
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



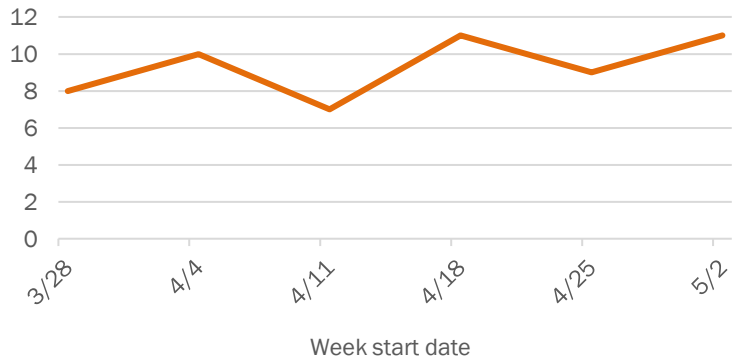
Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness
