


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath influenza-like illness












Daily percent of ED visits mentioning











Daily percent of ED visits mentioning
















Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents




Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Volusia County











Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness
